The Art High School Leaving Certificate Examination March 2012 will be conducted from 12/03/2012 to 24.03.2012 according to the time table as per this notification.

The examination is based on the revised curriculum prepared in accordance with the concept of continuous evaluation and its 9 point grading system. In part A, there will be 8 papers for the written examination including Information Technology and part B, there will be 4 papers including practical examination. The details are given below.

The Examination will be held at the Kerala Kalamandalam Art GHSS Cheruthuruthy, Vallathol Nagar, Thrissur – 678531

The Principal, Kerala Kalamandalam Govt Art HSS Cheruthuruthy will be the Chief Superintendent for conducting the examination.

1. CATEGORY OF CANDIDATES

a. Regular Candidates

Students studying in Std. X for the academic year 2011-2012 can appear for the examination as regular candidates. They should have also undergone the CE for each paper, under the new pattern of grading system introduced. The candidates who have not acquired the required percentage of attendance will not be admitted for the examination.

b) Private Candidates

Those candidates who have appeared in the examination in March 2007,2008,2009,2010 and 2011 and obtained D&E grades in any paper have to appear for the Examination as private candidates. Such candidates need only to appear for the papers that they obtained D&E grades. As per G.O.(MS) 148/2007 dated 04/08/2007 the Private Candidates (2004-2005 and 2005-2006) who are not eligible for higher studies shall appear for the Examination March 2012 under the New Scheme came into force from 2006-2007 academic year.

c. Attendance Recouped Candidate (ARC)

Candidates of 2010-2011 academic year who have undergone the continuous evaluation process during the course Standard X and not able to attend the Public Examination due to lack of attendance can appear the March 2012 as attendance recouped candidate. Such candidates should get necessary attendance this year from the same school.

d. Betterment of Result Candidates (BT)

Candidate who have already qualified for higher studies and wants to improve there grades can appear for the examination and better their results as per the following conditions.

1. The appearance for the betterment of result will be within a period of three years from the year of qualification.
2. The candidates should not have obtained any higher qualification during this period.
3. They can appear for examination only as full course.

II. PRACTICAL EXAMINATIONS

- a. IT Practical Examination will be conducted for a maximum score of 20. Out of this 18 score is for testing the IT skills and 2 scores for IT practical work book. The evaluation of the answer of the 18 score practical examination which is conducted using Software will be done by the teachers posted as invigilators of the practical examination. The Software will have provision for recording the score (Maximum 2) for the practical work book. The maximum time for the practical examination will be 45 minutes. **There will be no re-valuation for IT practical examination.**
- b. Practical Examination in Art subjects should be commenced after the written tests. The candidates should contact the Chief Superintendent of the Centre and ascertain the date of practical examination.

III. SAVE A YEAR (SAY) EXAMINATION

Those candidates(Regular) who are not qualified for higher studies in the2012 March AHSLC Examination are eligible for appearing the Save A Year (SAY) Examination which is proposed to be conducted by May 2012. Separate notification will be issued later in this regard.

The examination fee should collect and remit at treasury under the Head of Account "0202-01-102-99-Examination fee" and cost of certificate should remit under the Head of Account "0202-01-102-92-other receipts".

b. Exemption of fees

Students Below Poverty Line (BPL) appearing for the AHSLC Examination after completion of the course in Kerala Kalamandalam Government Art HSS Cheruthuruthy are exempted from the payment of fee for the first appearance, provided such appearance is at the close of the academic year in which the candidate studies in Standard X for the first time (G.O.(Rt) 3668/2001 GE. Dated,03.10.2001). Attendance Recouped, Betterment candidate are not eligible for this concession. In the case of regular students belonging to SC and other eligible communities they will be allowed such free appearance for two chances within a period of 3 years with effect from the date of completion of the course at Kerala Kalamandalam Art High Scholl (G.O. (MS) 32/74/GE. Dated, 18.02.1974)

Students belongs to ST are eligible for exemption from the payment of exam fee for 5 years inclusive of the benefit enjoyed prior to February 1981 (G.O.(RT) 680/81/GE. Dated, 25.02.1981)

Head of Institution may collect the examination fee and remit the amount at the Treasury and original Chalan receipt forwarded to this Office along with A& B List.

VII. PREPRATION OF A,B LIST

Immediately after the last date of receipt of examination fees, the Head of Institution should prepare the details of candidate in A and B list. In the case of regular candidates, the details should be prepared in A and B list. The details of Private candidate need be prepared only in B list.

VIII. CANCELLATION OF CANDIDATURE

If the candidature of a student has to be cancelled under certain circumstances, application for the same should be submitted in the specified format attached (Annexure C). The application should reach the Secretary to the Commissioner for Government Examinations before 28/02/2012. On the envelope in which the applications are enclosed, it should be noted as“ Application for Cancellation of Candidature” in red ink. **The candidature of those who have attended the IT practical Examination cannot be cancelled.**

IX. ADMISSION TICKETS

The admission Ticket of the Candidate will be issued by the Chief Superintendent at least three days before the commencement of Examination.

X. SCRUTINY, PHOTOCOPY AND REVALUATION OF VALUED ANSWER SCRIPTS

- a. Application from candidates in the form prescribed in Annexure B for scrutiny of valued answer scripts will be accepted only if received within 5 days from the date of publication of results. Fee for scrutiny Rs.50/- per paper.
- b. Application for revaluation of answer scripts (Theory Subjects) from the candidates in the form prescribed in Annexure B will be considered. The fee for revaluation of answer scripts is fixed for Rs.400/- per paper. Application for revaluation should be submitted to School Head Master within 5 days from the date of publication of results. Fresh certificates including the revised grade will be distributed through to the head of institute to those who procure higher grades. Along with this the amount paid for revaluation will also be reimbursed.
- c. Application for photocopy of answer scripts in Annexure B should be submitted within 5 days from the date of publication of results. The fee for Photocopy of the answer script is fixed as Rs. 200/- per paper. The fee for the Scrutiny, Photocopy and Revaluation should be remitted in cash along with it application to the Head of Institution.

XI IRREGULARITIES

Any candidate who commit or attempt to commit malpractice in the examination will be expelled immediately and will not be allowed to sit for any other paper subsequently in the examination. Candidates are not allowed to bring with them any written or printed matter. Copying from

another candidate or giving convenience to any candidate will be considered as malpractice. If any candidate behaves in any unruly manner either in the examination hall or in the premises of the institution where examination is conducted will be expelled from the examination by the Chief Superintendent. Any candidate expelled from the examination either for malpractice or for unruly behavior may be further debarred from appearing for subsequent examination for specified number of chance as decided later

XII. DISTRIBUTION OF AHSLC CARDS

The blank AHSLC cards will be sent to the school from this Office for filling the biodata part of the card and retransmission. After obtaining it and entering the grades, the Certificates will be sent to Principal, AHS Kalamandalam for distribution. The principal will have to enter the details of the AHSLC card in the duplicate register before distributing it to the students. The signatures shall be collected in a separate register before issuing the AHSLC card. **The biodata part of the card will have to be filled Only in capital letters, using black ink.**

Xiii. All Candidates appearing for the examination should furnish an undertaking that they will abide by all the rules and regulations in force in respect of the examination.
