### **I INTRODUCTION**

It is hereby notified that the examination in Kerala Govt. Certificate in Fine Arts will be conducted from 16/1/2012 as per the time table appended. As per Govt order reference first cited it is ordered that the newly introduced KGCE Fine Arts course may be conducted for the candidates who are studying for the course in Private Recognized institutions.

### **II ELIGIBILITY**

Admission to the Examination is restricted to those only who have completed the prescribed course of two year from a recognized institute for the academic year ended April 2011. Candidates who have failed in any of the subject can also appear the examination. The school going candidates must secure 80% attendance for the academic year. Those who failed to secure 80%, but secured above 65% may apply for condonation on genuine reason. Those who failed to get even condonation will have to repeat the course in the same class for one more year. Only two chances will be allowed to undergo the course in a class. The condonation for shortage of attendance will be sanctioned by concerned Regional Joint Director /Dy. Director (General) of Directorate of Technical Education on getting applications from concerned institution with required details and Chalan receipt for remittance fee.

Those who have successfully completed the course in a Government/recognized private industrial school can appear for the above examination. The minimum educational qualification is SSLC (failed/passed).

1. Candidate passing all subjects in first chance securing an aggregate of 60% marks and above will be declared to have passed the examination in the first class.
2. A candidate passing all subject in the first chance securing an aggregate 50% marks and above but below 60% will be declared to have passed the examination in the second class.
3. All other successful candidate will be declared to have passed the examination in third class.
4. A candidate who fails in any of the subject need to apply in the failed subject as a whole for examination, piece-meal appearance will not be entertained.
5. A candidate will not be allowed to appear for the examination for more than 4 chances.
6. There will be no supplementary examinations. Only one examination will be conducted in an academic year.
7. **There will not be any revaluation for this examination. Scrutiny of Answer paper is allowed.**

#### **IV INSTRUCTIONS**

The candidates who have studied in the Private Recognised Institution and completed the course during 2009-2011 can appear for this examination as regular candidate. They should submit their applications in the prescribed form to the Head of Institution from where they had undergone the course. **The Head of Institutions will collect all such applications and send the same through the examination centre concerned along with Chalan receipt of fee collected (Specified in Para 6) to the Secretary to the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Pareeksha Bhavan, Poojappura Thiruvananthapuram – 12 within the prescribed time limit.** Copy of order granting recognition to the institution should also be enclosed without fail. Name of Examination centers are given as ANNEXURE – B.

#### **V. PREPARATION OF A & B LISTS, APPLICATION etc.**

A specimen application is enclosed as Appendix – I. Identification Certificate and admission ticket are also enclosed as Appendix II and III respectively. Application form have to be get filled up from the candidates along with the identification certificate and Hall tickets. Two passport size photographs of the candidate should be obtained and one should be pasted in the identification certificate and the other one in the hall ticket. Both photograph should properly be identified by either Gazetted Officer or by the Head of the Institution. The same should be prepared carefully with permanent black ink so as to keep the B list as a permanent documents of this office. Entries with ball pen should be avoided. The names of candidate should be arranged alphabetically and entered with correct spelling as seen in the SSLC Book. Separate sheets for school going candidates and private candidates should be used. True copy of the General Qualification Certificate, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or by the Head of the High School or Training School should be enclosed along with the application and other documents. After preparing 'A' and 'B' lists the following declaration should be furnished at the bottom of both lists by the Head of the institutions with proper authentication "Certified that the above candidate have prescribed minimum qualification and that they have completed the prescribed course of study".

## **VI EXAMINATION FEE**

Government, as per G.O 2<sup>nd</sup> cited have revised the rate of examination fee as shown below.

Fee for full course	Rs. 400/-
Fee for one paper	Rs. 150/-
Fee for Scrutiny per paper	Rs. 50/-

The Head of Institution should collect the examination fee as noted above and fee for mark list Rs. 40/- from each candidate and remit the same into the Treasury in the prescribed time as per the programme shown below. Examination fee and fee for mark list should be remitted in the respective Head of Account. Both Chalan receipts should be forwarded along with other documents.

All the candidates except students belonging to SC/ST, Kudumbies and X'ian converts from among them, should remit examination fees. Students who are exempted from payment of fees are eligible to appear for only two chances, provided that the second chance should be within a period of 3 years from the first appearance. In the case of fees exempted categories, the Head of Institutions should furnish a certificate to the effect that this is the First/Second appearance of the candidate, in their application.

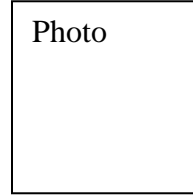
